OKAA Quarterly Meeting Minutes

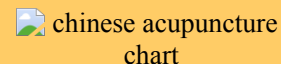

The quarterly meeting of the Oklahoma Acupuncture Association was held on March 7, 2009 in the home of Angela Brazeal in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The business meeting was preceded by a potluck luncheon and a presentation on Jin Shen Jitsu by Mark Hoveis of Tulsa. Members present were President Jamie Whartenby, Vice President Angela Brazeal, Secretary/Treasurer Deborah Bright, Amit Guman and fiancée Mickey, Jeff and Shirley Nicholson, Mark Hovis, Sharon Brown, Yvonne Van Eijk, and Bhavani Oakley Indu, Cari and John Mack, John Yang, Debra Baker, Sharon Brown, Eldon St. Clair and Stacia Brown.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved and the financial statement was presented.



Discussion and planning for April 18th and 19th professional development workshop featuring Li Jun Feng, the head of the International Sheng Zhen Society Foundation, as well as its principal teacher was carried out. Shirley Nicholson confirmed that there will be 12 CEU/PDA's for the workshop from NCAAOM for acupuncturists. Dr Li is known as having been the head coach of the world-renowned Beijing Wushu Team of the People's Republic of China for 15 years. He currently dedicates himself solely to the teaching and practice of the Sheng Zhen forms of qigong. He also serves as advisor to the World Academic Society of Medical Qigong and the Qigong Science Research Association of China.
