Committee for certification within the OKAA

Deborah Bright and Dr.John Yang proposed to drop the grandfathering into the certification of the OKAA per September 1, 2012. Tim Williamson second, all in favor. Lars, our webmaster will be notified of making changes on our website about this.


Recommendation -Requirement effective September 1, 2012 for anyone who applies for certification within the OKAA must either reside and practice in OK, they must be in OK before they make application and also contingent with that they must come for a short interview and meet with the committee. There will be 4 of those opportunities per year scheduled on our regular quarterly meeting dates for those applicants.

So those who apply from out of state or out of the country we will first have to meet with them, before we will give a certification
